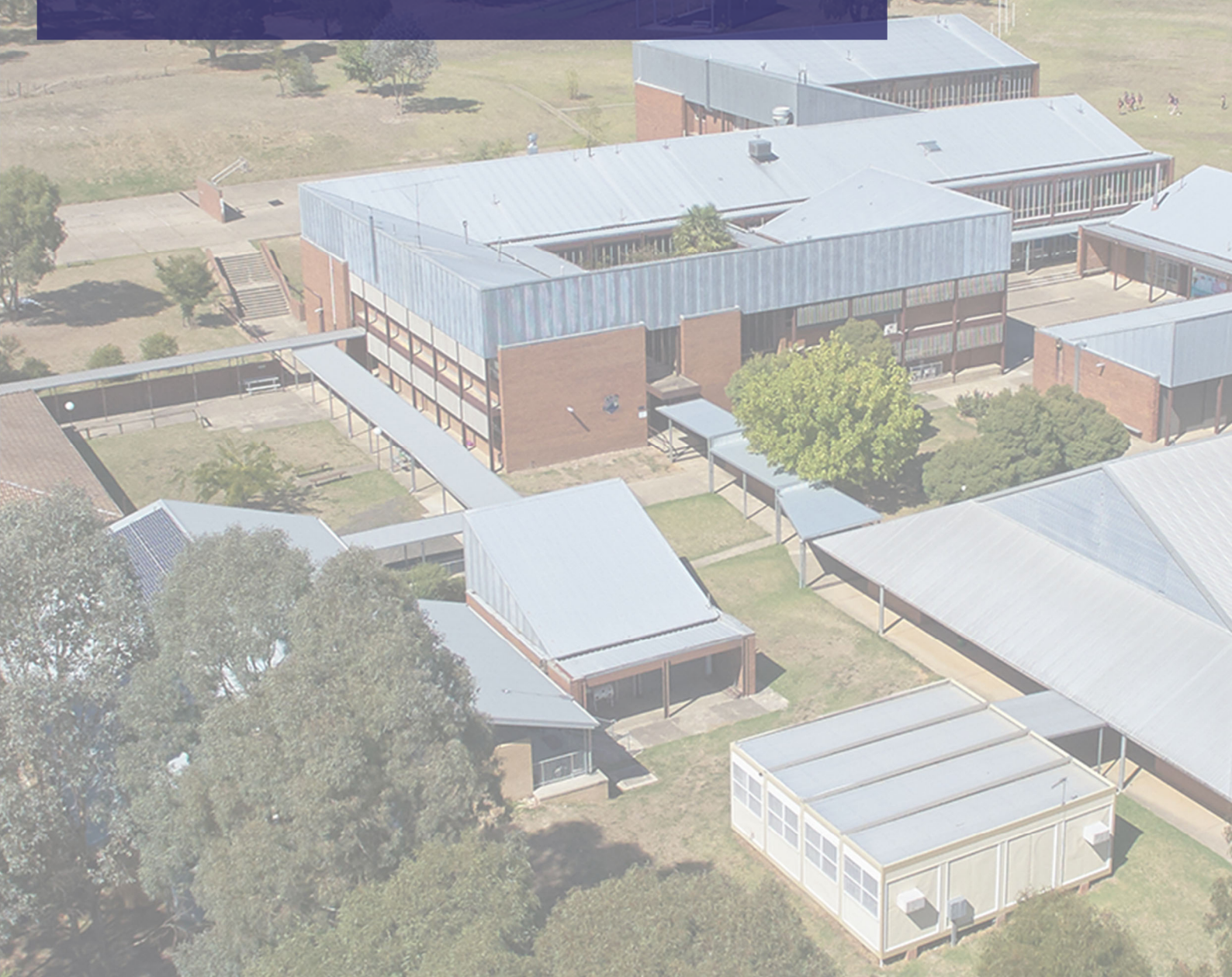

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

It is my pleasure to welcome students, parents and carers, family and friends, along with official guests and staff, to Tumbarumba High School's 2023 Presentation Night which marks the end of the academic school year. I would like to acknowledge the traditional custodians of the land on which we, as members of the school community, meet tonight and pay my sincere respects to elders – past, present and emerging, including those who are students at our school.

I would like to sincerely commend the students of Tumbarumba High School for your efforts in 2023. The recipients of academic, cultural, sporting and special awards and commendable certificates are to be warmly congratulated on their efforts and application. I hope that you have realised that our school community is one that genuinely encourages and acknowledges the maxim: Excellence (that is, personal excellence) and Opportunity for All. We continue to encourage students to take the initiative and to embrace positive opportunities that are made available.

2023 has been an impressive year for Tumbarumba High School students in terms of their sporting and cultural endeavours. As you will gleam from tonight's extensive Sport Report, so many of our students have excelled in individual and team competitions at local, zone and state levels, in an array of sports, including rugby league, lawn bowls, athletics, swimming and cross country. Our students have represented our school in cultural forums - including music camps, the much-celebrated William Dobbell Art School and an eisteddfod - which has enabled them to develop and showcase their talents. Our SRC students have participated in civic and leadership programs, including the New South Wales and Commonwealth Constitution Conventions, a Youth Leadership and Business Summit and the GRIP Leadership Conference. It is amazing what students from a small rural high school - with the support of teachers, parents, community groups and businesses - can do!

In 2023 Tumbarumba High School successfully implemented a structured Mathematics program called QuickSmart to develop and enhance students' numeracy skills and confidence. Thanks are extended to Ms Joanne Donovan and Mrs Carmel Smith for their coordination of this program and the amazing enthusiasm and commitment of our SLSOs, Mrs Catherine Bremner and Mr Ty Hussell, who ensured that this program was so effective and engaging for our students. In 2023 we maintained a Year 11 Mentor Program under the guidance of SLSO Miss Triniti Hussell to support students in Year 11 with study tips and advice as they transitioned from Year 10 into the demands of senior courses. In addition, student wellbeing has been the central objective of The Resilience Project (TRP) which has been delivered to students in Years 7-8 by our School Chaplain, Mr Kane Stewart, and our interim Student Support Officer, Mrs Jacyn Evans.

Our teachers and students in Year 11 and 12 have continued to harness the quality teaching and learning resources of the Rural Learning Exchange (RLE) which operates across a growing number of rural and remote schools in New South Wales. Senior classes, including Business Studies, Biology and Agriculture, were able to share common assessments and curriculum with schools partnering in the exchange. Our students have embraced the opportunities afforded through Distance Education to tackle subjects such as Chemistry and Advanced Mathematics. Our students in Years 11-12 have also accessed virtual TAFE subjects – including Automotive, Entrepreneurship, Construction, Allied Health, Game Design and Business Administration - via TAFE's LaunchPad program. A significant number of our students in Years 9, 10 and 11 have accessed successful Work Experience placements under the school's umbrella – with so many of these leading to full-time

apprenticeships or gainful employment and a growing number of School-based Apprenticeships (SBAT) in growth sectors such as health and hospitality.

There have been significant changes to the ranks of our teaching staff. Mrs Vanessa McGrath assumed the substantive position as Head Teacher Science-Agriculture-Library and Miss Brigid Rhynehart assumed the substantive position as Head Teacher Secondary Studies. When executive and senior executive staff have accessed leave, other incredibly capable teaching staff - including Mrs Sophie McGruer, Miss Jane Chivers, Mrs Hayley Williams and Mrs Sharnelle McGee – have willingly stepped up to assume Acting Head Teacher roles and responsibilities. During my own extended absences from the school, I have been grateful and rest assured to have Mrs Megan Finnimore assume the Relieving Principal's role and Mr Derek Smith assume the Relieving Deputy Principal's role. A significant number of our teachers and SASS staff have also obtained permanency with the NSW Department of Education under a new state government initiative during Terms 3 and 4.

2023 marked the implementation of Tumbarumba High School's attendance incentive program. This has rewarded our students for high and improved rates of full day school attendance. Indeed, the advent of attendance dollars came at an opportune time – and enabled our students' attendance dollars to offset the costs of major interstate (including the Tasmania Excursion) and sporting excursions. Thanks are extended to our staff, including Mrs Megan Finnimore, Mrs Sophie McGruer, Mrs Rachel Crozier and Mrs Tegan Arnold, who developed and refined the systems and structures to ensure that such a program operated to benefit our students.

Our dedicated staff have so often gone that extra mile to inspire and support students with Enrichment Initiatives. These initiatives have supported students to attend major sporting events across all corners of the state; enabled students to access an enriched curriculum - including the Banquer High School Stage 4 Commence program and agricultural forums in Dubbo convened by the Australian Agricultural Centre; and allowed the purchase of an upgraded computer to support the school's new 3D printer. Excursions and wellbeing-focused year group excursions and programs have provided contexts in which to develop relationships and kindle friendships that then support students during their schooling and beyond. This year also marked the introduction of a Lunchtime Sport Program which has allowed our students and staff to engage in fun team sports, including badminton, netball and touch football.

As we commence the Interest Electives program of 2023, enjoy time with your peers - make new friends and acquaintances, make new connections which will support you during your time at school and beyond. As you embrace the 2024 school year, strive to do your best – embrace challenges and opportunities: enrichment tasks, academic, cultural and sporting competitions and other opportunities that will develop your knowledge, skills and confidence which will ultimately promote a sense of belonging within our very special and resilient school community.

It would be remiss of me not to thank the members of Tumbarumba High School's Parents and Citizens' Association under the leadership of our new P&C President, Mrs Robyn Foley, for their effort, support and guidance. The school community acknowledges your contributions to Public Education in Tumbarumba.

In closing, on behalf of the school community, I would like to wish you all a Merry Christmas and a safe and wonderful holiday period – which will leave you all deservedly rested and relaxed - and therefore ready to strive for your best in 2024.

P & C REPORT

The Tumbarumba High School Parents and Citizens' Association (P&C) is a small, dedicated team of parents and citizens who meet once a term, generally in the school library. As of 2024, we will meet on the 3rd Tuesday of each term. The Annual General Meeting will be held in conjunction with the Term 2 P&C's General Meeting.

All parents, carers and members of the wider community are most welcome and encouraged to attend our meetings. New members are not required to assume an executive role; however, they are invited to contribute to the forum. Discussions in the meetings range from new policies being implemented in the school, such as the attendance dollars incentive program, to school uniforms, funding requirements of the school and other factors effecting the running of the school.

Joining the committee does not involve a huge time commitment. Mostly it is just to turn up at the meetings and have a say in what is happening at the school. Fundraising for the school is typically undertaken by the SRC and students themselves, giving them ownership and appreciation of the effort involved. The P&C manages existing funds and keeps a lookout for grant opportunities. A generous contribution was made to the school a few years ago and some of this remains in a term deposit. The committee uses discretion as to what this money is spent on.

In 2023, the P&C has managed the existing funds - rolling over and adjusting term deposits to get the best return on the accrued investment. A portion of these funds was assigned to the school by the P&C to purchase new stools for students to use in the Tumbarumba High School Visual Arts room. We determined that this was a worthy purchase for the whole school community and would benefit students for many years to come. This coincided with school's self-funded upgrade of benches, desks and cabinets in the Visual Arts room.

The Tumbarumba High School P&C enjoyed the opportunity to represent parents and community members on the interview panels which were responsible for the appointments of two executive teachers this year. I also had the pleasure of attending the Year 12 Farewell Assembly as the P&C President, assisted with verification of the calculation for the 1st of Year awards and also also represented P&C at the Parents and Carers' Information Session for 2024 Year 7 students and families.

I offer a sincere thank you to the existing dedicated parents and citizens who have attended and supported our meetings. Jointly, we look forward to welcoming new members into Tumbarumba High School's P&C next year, to support the school and thereby maximise students' opportunities in the school.

SPORT REPORT 2023

In 2023, Tumbarumba High School has sustained its vibrant spirit and success in sports, witnessing active participation from students across various sporting activities and competitions. Throughout this year, the school community has upheld an outstanding dedication to embracing new sports and fostering team participation to compete regularly in school events. Tumbarumba High School's presence has extended to multiple levels including school, Zone, Regional, and State championships in an array of sports such as Swimming, Athletics, Cross Country, Touch Football, Netball, Basketball, Table Tennis, Tennis, Cricket, Rugby League, and League Tag.

It began with Deegan Lesniak breaking Jack Vogan's record from 2008 in 14 years boys 50m Freestyle. Jack's previous record was 32.42 seconds and Deegan's new record is 31.97 seconds. Unfortunately, the students were too good for the staff and won the annual Staff vs Students race. Congratulations to the sporting house of Hughes for taking out the annual Swimming Carnival for 2023.

Another sporting arena that saw some great achievements this year was the Athletics Carnival. In 2023, Tumbarumba High School had great participation and house spirit, with Hughes again taking the title for this event. Great performances were seen through a variety of age groups, with the following students breaking Tumbarumba High School records, Peyton Livet broke Emily Hulm's record from 1997 in the 100m 13 years and Akia Wilson's record from 2021 in 13 years High Jump. Phoebe Richards broke Angel Horsley's record from 2013 in the 13 years Long Jump. Jessica Clarke broke Kylie Foster's record from 1985 in the 14 years High Jump. Angus Thomson broke the 14 years boys javelin record with a new record of 23.4m.

Special congratulations to the following students who competed at the Combined High School Athletics championships in Sydney Olympic Park, for a variety of events including our U14's girls 4x100m relay team, consisting of Jessica Clarke, Matilda McPherson, Peyton Livet and Phoebe Richards, along with individual events; Sam Clarke 16 years discus and javelin, Jessica Clarke 14 years High Jump, Phoebe Richards 13 years 100m, Bonnie Mycroft 17 years High Jump.

Once again, Tumbarumba High School students demonstrated great achievements at the Southern Slopes Zone Cross Country event. Excellent achievements were seen by Reece Hulm, Bonnie Mycroft and Brylie Richards, receiving the Southern Slopes Zone Age Champion award in their respective age groups.

Riverina Cross Country was another event where students experienced success with the following students qualifying for the Combined High School Cross Country championships at Eastern Creek. Declan Shore and Darcy Finnimore (15 years boys), Grace Finnimore and Bonnie Mycroft (17 years girls), Brylie Richards and Stephanie Bergin (18 years girls) and Preston Hussell (18 Years boys). This is the most success Tumbarumba High School has had at the Combined High School State Cross Country event.

Students have demonstrated prowess across a range of sporting endeavours at both a school and broader community level, including the participation in the Inclusive Education Boccia event held in Wagga Wagga for the first time at our school.

Year 9 student, Deegan Lesniak, was selected in the U15's Riverina Rugby League team. The Riverina team faced a more experienced and sizable team, playing against the South Coast in Queanbeyan. From this game, Deegan was successfully selected to represent Southern NSW to play in Wollongong in May. He was also successfully selected in the U15's Schoolboys First Nations team at the Australian Secondary Schools Rugby League team.
